These ATG tube lamps have been in use since 2002 with no safety incidents or concerns. Is it because the Energy Star program is focused on residential as opposed to commercial lighting? We ask that you reconsider including these LED T-8 tube replacement lamps in the Energy Star specifications so that we can apply for rebates to help offset the initial cost of these lamps in states like Connecticut which require Energy Star certification.
