Dear ENERGY STAR® Certification Bodies,

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has released updates to <u>Directive #2011-06</u>, <u>ENERGY STAR Verification Testing Supplement</u>. This update revises the list of products eligible for off-the-line procurement and testing, and establishes that CBs are no longer required to procure verification lighting samples from three geographically diverse locations.
