The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) would like to inform you that the XML-based webservice for submitting data on Consumer Refrigeration Products certified to the ENERGY STAR® version 5.0 specification has been updated to allow you to submit products certified to version 5.1. The web service field updates are summarized below.

 - Refrigerants that are listed as Ozone Depleting Substances and are not allowed to be used per Federal Regulations, such as R-401A or R-22.
- Connected Demand Response Functionality Tested
 - Updated field description to note that:
 - Required if Connected Functionality is Yes and the model is not a cooler.
