The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is releasing a revised Nov-2013 version of the Final Version 1.0 ENERGY STAR Small Network Equipment Program Requirements, which contains minor editorial changes. In addition, EPA has also developed a sample calculations document in response to stakeholder requests for examples. Changes from the previous Aug-2013 of the program requirements are summarized below:

## Eligibility Criteria

• Updated the external power supplies references (Section 3.2.1) to the most current applicable Level V performance requirements under the International Efficiency Marking Protocol.

## **Test Method**

- Minor editorial revision in Section 6.4 to provide more clarity in item 8), by separating into two items, 8) and 9).
- Correction to Figure numbering throughout the document.
  - Addition of missing text in Figure 1

## Sample Calculations

- Example calculations of P<sub>AVG\_MAX</sub> in the Eligibility Criteria for three different example products.
- Additional explanation and two examples of usage of Section 7.1.A of the Test Method
